- I. Call to order**
  - a. CCA President Irv Hollingsworth called the meeting to order at 7PM and welcomed board members and guests.
- II. 2015 Annual Membership Meeting Minutes**
  - a. Discussed and approved.
- III. Treasurer's Report**
  - a. Reviewed and approved.
- IV. Board Membership**
  - a. New board members were nominated and elected for three-year terms. Existing board members Beth Langseder, Alan Lividos, Catherine Nessa and Matt Terrell were re-elected for three-year terms. - V. Other Business**
  - a. Serial litterer: trash has been dumped on both ends of the village near the Streetscape signs for the past several months [?]. New Castle County police have been advised. Other options on how to handle the situation were discussed, including offering a cash reward. Irv Hollingsworth made plans to contact state police and advise the board accordingly.
  - b. The Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) reported briefly on the newly installed traffic light at Twaddell and Owl's Nest roads; no serious issues have been reported. The schedule for the installation of the new crosswalks was not introduced.
  - c. The 2016 summer concert series was reviewed and approved.
  - d. Sign repair: Casey Stein agreed to make repairs to the north island sign.
  - e. The 2016 annual streetscape maintenance plan was approved and accepted by DelDOT.
  - f. The possibility of a return of a monthly Farmers Market including five local farmers was discussed.

  - a. Senator Lavelle was in attendance and offered his willingness to work with and support CCA. Sen. Lavelle also commented briefly on activity in the Legislature.
  - b. Representative Deborah Hudson was not in attendance.

  - a. Michael Hahn from DelDOT presented an update of the state's national scenic byways program. Delaware currently has six byways: The Brandywine Valley National Scenic Byway, Red Clay Scenic

Byway, Delaware's Bayshore Byway, Harriet Tubman Underground Railroad Byway, Lewes, Gateway to the Nation Byway and Nanticoke Heritage Byway.
